

1 pad of drawing paper, medium weight, 18x24 inches  
(Important: Please get "DRAWING" paper, not "SKETCH" paper. )

drawing board

kneaded erasers

drawing pencils H, HB, 2B, 4B, 6B

compressed charcoal sticks, soft

vine charcoal

1 stick of Creta Color charcoal black (should cost around \$2 or \$3). It comes in a cylinder, and is fairly short, very velvety black.

charcoal holder recommended for the compressed charcoal

1 charcoal pencil, black (soft, if they are characterized that way.)

1 charcoal pencil, white

portable pencil sharpener for pencils and charcoal sticks
