The following supply list is for your reference. You may bring whatever supplies you already have and you may also need to purchase a few from the list below.

If you are a BEGINNER you will need:

Bamboo knitting needles (long), suggested sizes 8, 10 & 13  
Bamboo, double pointed needles, suggested size 8  
Stitch gauge  
Calculator  
Measuring tape  
Scissors  
Small package of various crochet hooks

Yarn we will be using for small projects: "ENCORE" by Plymouth Yarn, worsted weight 75% acrylic/25% wool, or a comparable wool yarn to be used on a size 8 needle. "Encore" is available at the Knitting Basket, inexpensive with a lot of yardage.

You may also want to buy a novelty yarn we will be using for embellishments (you may want to purchase this after the first class).

If you are an INTERMEDIATE knitter you may bring a project of your choice to class or follow along with projects I have planned.

Projects we will be working on in class will include (your choice): scarves, handbags, jewelry, cell-phone covers, hats, leg warmers and all types of fun embellishments and finishes.

I will have plenty of needles and basic supplies on-hand for the first workshop, including patterns for planned projects, however you will have to bring yarn to work with as suggested above or yarn and a pattern for a project of your choice. I will also have some alternative knitting materials on-hand you may purchase from me during class.
