

## ***Drawing Supplies---Portrait and Figure Drawing With David Tanner***

One (1) **18”X24” charcoal sketch pad** (or approximately that size), suitable for pencil and/or charcoal. This is a pretty versatile size. **Strathmore 300 Series** is a good brand to look for, among others.

One (1) set of **drawing/ sketching pencils**. Look for a set of 4 pencils, sizes HB, 2B, 4B, and 6B, or you could buy these grades individually.

One (1) medium grade **charcoal pencil**.

One (1) No. 2 **Conte Stick**, Black

**Vine Charcoal, Soft & Medium**---2 or 3 sticks

One (1) medium sized **kneaded eraser**.

One (1) rolled paper **blending stick**.

One (1) **chamois** cloth, used for lifted up and softening charcoal applied to paper.
