ABOUT THIS SESSION

This catalog includes primarily online classes, with a few on-site classes for students ages 15-18. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Visual Arts Center of Richmond is currently open by appointment only for staff, members of our Community Studio Rental Program and a limited number of small, on-site classes.

To keep our on-site students safe, we're closely following guidelines put in place by public health officials. We're taking precautions to ensure that all studios are sanitized regularly and that everyone in the building is practicing social distancing. Masks are required at all times in our building.

How VisArts' online classes work: In order to participate, you must have a computer, smartphone or tablet with an internet connection. All classes will be taught using Zoom, a remote video conferencing service. VisArts staff will be accessible to support students with technical issues. How supplies work for online classes: For most online classes, students will need to purchase or gather supplies from a list that is posted online along with the full class description. Classes with the * symbol in this catalog require students to bring or buy materials for the class. ABOUT THE VISUAL ARTS CENTER OF RICHMOND

The Visual Arts Center of Richmond (VisArts) has helped adults and children explore their creativity and make art since 1963. Each year, the organization touches the lives of nearly 45,000 people through its classes, exhibitions, community outreach programs, camps, workshops and special events.

Founded in Church Hill as the Hand Workshop, the organization moved to the historic Virginia Dairy building at 1812 West Main Street, where it leased space for 17 years before purchasing and later renovating the building. Completed in 2007, the renovation transformed the facility into an inviting and inspiring 30,000-square-foot art center, which includes the 1,800-square-foot True F. Luck Gallery. The gallery's focus is on materials and processes of contemporary artists.
